ORDER NO. CH-1048

Approving the Charter to an Alien of
the Tanker JOSIAH HOLLAND


WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Phoenix Steamship Corporation, New York, N.Y., for the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act, 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the voyage charter of the tanker JOSIAH HOLLAND (to be renamed CYGNET III), Official No. 244322, to Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Company, Ltd., a British corporation, for three consecutive voyages covering the transportation of fuel oil or diesel oil, as follows: loading at a port or ports in the United States Gulf/Caribbean for discharging at a port or ports in the United Kingdom/Continent/Bordeaux-Hamburg range/Gibraltar, with option of discharging at a port or ports at East coast South America, but not north of Rio de Janeiro, lay days April 1 to April 30, 1948:

IT IS ORDERED, This 18th day of March 1948, that the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the voyage charter of the tanker JOSIAH HOLLAND (to be renamed CYGNET III), Official No. 244322, to an alien as above set forth, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition (1) that said voyages shall be completed by September 30, 1948; and (2) that said vessel shall not be sub-chartered to aliens except as provided in General Order #59, as amended.
