1. Information received in this office by TWX message 091903, dated 10-9-44 indicates that Joe Raymond DOKUPIL, O.S. aboard the SS HOLLAND, lost his Certificate of Identification Z-358205 and applied for duplicate papers on 5-23-44 in New York City.

2. Upon interviewing DOKUPIL, in Jacksonville, Fla., on 11 October, 1944, it was ascertained that he is sailing under his original papers. He applied for duplicate papers in New York City in May, 1944 upon losing his originals; however, his original papers were found and returned to him immediately after making application for the duplicate set in New York. DOKUPIL stated that the Merchant Marine Inspection Office in New York advised him to continue sailing under his original papers and that his application for a duplicate set would be cancelled.

3. DOKUPIL was advised to bring this matter to the attention of the Merchant Marine Inspection Office located at Galveston, Texas, the vessel's next port of call, in order for them to verify the New York Office's cancellation of his application for a duplicate set of papers and to ascertain which set of papers he is to use in the future.
