MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,  
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received from a reliable source the following information concerning Earl L. Mathewson, Radio Operator on the SS JUAN CABRILLO. It is alleged that Mathewson indiscriminately revealed to members of the crew of the SS JUAN CABRILLO, in August 1943, confidential information received in radio intercepts. It is also alleged that he divulged information as to the ship's position during this recent voyage.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action may prove warranted in this case.
