St. Sc. JUAN DE FUCA


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission, on January 29, 1948, authorized the sale of its steam screw JUAN DE FUCA (ex-ARANER), Official No. 242751, to the Asia Development Corporation, a company established and existing under the laws of the Republic of China, with offices at Shanghai, China, pursuant to Contract No. MCC-61131, dated February 2, 1948, which provides that the hull or hulk of said vessel shall be completely scrapped, dismembered, dismantled, or destroyed:

IT IS ORDERED, This 11th day of March 1948, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 41 of the Shipping Act, 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 839), of the sale of the steam screw JUAN DE FUCA (ex-ARANER), Official No. 242751, to an alien, as above set forth, be, and it is hereby granted.
