1. Subject vessel departed Mayaguez, Puerto Rico, 9 Nov 43.
2. The following passengers were paneled:
 - A. LOFTHOUSE, Joseph - US - Bos'n. - age 38 - res.: 116 Rodney St., New Bedford, Mass. - no derogatory information on subject.
 - B. ✓ MARVEL, Fergus John - US - OS - age 27 - res.: 2 North 16th St., East Orange, N.J. - Reference (a) in part states that subject's seaman's papers were suspended by Merchant Marine Inspector at San Juan, PR, for one year from 9 Dec 42. Upon appeal to District Coast Guard Officer by subject, suspension was reduced to 3 months. Subject exhibited Form 16-B-66 issued by DIO LOND at San Juan, PR, dated 13 Oct 43, granting permission to ship as a crewman, good for 10 days from date, and signed by Lt.(jg) Wade C. Hoyt, USNR, "By direction". Subject stated he was inducted into the Army, 3 May 43 and discharged 17 May 43 at San Juan, PR and classified 4-F.
3. District Coast Guard Officer (New York) was advised of arrival of John Fergus MARVEL.
