1. The American Tanker "KEWANEE".

was inspected this date and the following armament was found on board:

GUNS: One 4" 50 Cal. Placed aft on a Platform.

AMMUNITION: 90 Rds 4" 50 Cal, Armor piercing.

SMALL ARMS: Four 45 Cal automatic Pistols.

AMMUNITION: 220 Rds 45 Cal Automatic Pistol.

MAGAZINE: Two, one aft below decks and one foreward on main deck under the Forecastle head.

FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT: Sprinkler system, Telephone from Gun deck to Bridge and Buzzer to Bridge.

GUNS CREWS: Coxswain in charge and six Sea 2/c.

REMARKS: Vessel is Degoused, has placement for one heavy calibre Gun foreward on the Forecastle head, and for two Machine Guns on top of the Pilot House. Ammunition ready box aft on Gun platform for 25 Rds for 4" 50 Cal.
