1. The American Tanker "KEWANEE"

was inspected this date and the following armament was found on board:

GUNS: One 4 inch 50 Cal. Placed aft on a Platform.

AMMUNITION: 90 Rds 4 inch 50 Cal armor piercing.

SMALL ARMS: 4 Automatic Pistols 45 Cal.

AMMUNITION: 90Rds Automatic Pistol 45 Cal.

MAGAZINE: Two one aft below decks and one foreward on the main deck under the Forecastle head.

FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT: Sprinkler System. Telephone from aft Gun Platform to Bridge and Foreward Gun deck.

GUNS CREWS: Eight men in the Gun crew, Coxswain in charge and 7 Sea 2/c.

REMARKS: Vessel is Degaused, Has placement on top of Forecastle head for one heavy calibre Gun, also has placement on top of Pilot House for two Machine Guns. Has one ammunition ready box aft on Gun deck for 25 Rds.
