INTELLIGENCE DIVISION MEMORANDUM NO. 75-44. SUBJECT IS A NARCOTIC SUSPECT. SUBMIT FINGERPRINTS ON FORM NCG-2515. PREPARE AND SUBMIT FORM NAVCG-2765.

2. THOMAS admits he is the Charles S. THOMAS who was taken into custody as he left the SS WARRIOR in New York City around 8 August, 1944. Subject named man admits he was an occasional user of marihuana cigarettes but is not an addict, and he maintains that he has not had any marihuana in his possession since the incident of August, 1944.

3. THOMAS'S Z certificate was endorsed for security by this office, and Forms 2765 and 2515 submitted.
