

KLIPFONTEIN, boarded 15 July, 1941 (Continued)

ARMS

6 revolvers, 250 rounds ammunition. 106 rockets, signal lights.

Two places on boat deck reinforced for machine gun mounts, also both sides of forecastle head. Decks reinforced. 5" gun platform aft. on top of after deck house.

REMARKS

Fuel on hand 858 tons; water on hand 120 tons, take here 400 tons.

Three bags of mail for Honolulu, fifty-two for coast.

Maximum speed 21 knots, cruising speed 16.5 knots.

One U.S. ship sighted. Follows route laid out by Naval Authorities. Unconvoyed.

NOJIMA MARU in Manila when KLIPFONTEIN at that port.

Little Japanese traffic noted. Neither operator qualified to copy Orange code.
