
1. The DUTCH M.V. "KOTA AGOENG"

DEGREES, ARC. OF TRAIN, 30 to 330 DEGREES. MOUNTED ON RAISED PLATFORM TWENTY  
FIVE (25) FEET FROM STERN OF SHIP.AMMUNITION: FORTY (50) SHELLS, (TNT- BP CHARGE).SMALL ARMS: TWO (2) WINCHESTER RIFLES.  
FOUR (4) COLT REVOLVERS.AMMUNITION: TWO HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE (225) ROUNDS FOR FIFLES.  
TWO HUNDRED (200) ROUNDS FOR REVOLVERS.MAGAZINE: LOCATED ON MAIN DECK, UNDER BUILT UP PLATFORM FOR GUN.FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT: TELEPHONE CONNECTION FROM GUN TO  
BRIDGE.GUNS CREWS: SEVEN (7) MEN IN GUNS CREW: INCLUDING ONE (1) EX NAVY GUNLAYER.REMARKS: DEGAUSSING GEAR: TWO (2) SMOKE FLOATS, FIFTEEN (15) SUITS GAS  
PROTECTED CLOTHING. FIFTY THREE (53) SERVICE GAS MASKS.
