TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-5008

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to Brazilian Registry and Flag of the
Undocumented Oil Screw
"HOPE"

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Conlon and Tendler, Washington, D. C. for the approval required by Section 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 835), of the sale of the oil screw vessel "HOPE" (ex-LST-290), undocumented, to Paulo Leite Carneiro, a Brazilian citizen, residing in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, with transfer to Brazilian registry and flag:


IT IS ORDERED, This 31st day of January 1947, that the approval required by Section 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 835), of the sale of the undocumented oil screw vessel "HOPE" (ex-LST 290), to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Brazilian registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens nor encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
