TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-4571 (a)

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to Chinese  
Registry and Flag of the Undocumented LST 766

WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission, by its Transfer Order No. C-4571, dated October 11, 1946, granted its administrative approval as required by Section 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 835) of the sale by the Commission of the Undocumented LST 766 to Pedro Bidegaray, a Peruvian citizen, represented by R. G. Craerin, Washington, D. C., and the transfer of said vessel to Peruvian registry and flag; and


WHEREAS, Pedro Bidegaray now desires without first documenting the vessel under Peruvian law, to sell said vessel to Ming Sung Industrial Company, Ltd., a Chinese company, with transfer to Chinese ownership, registry and flag, and has applied to the Commission for an amendment of said Transfer Order No. C-4571 to permit this being done:

IT IS ORDERED, This 22nd day of November 1946, that Transfer Order No. C-4571, dated October 11, 1946, be, and it is hereby modified so as to permit the transfer of the Undocumented LST 766 by Ming Sung Industrial Company, Ltd., to Chinese registry and flag.
