1. Inbound and outbound crew list was checked through the files of the DIO, 6ND with negative results.

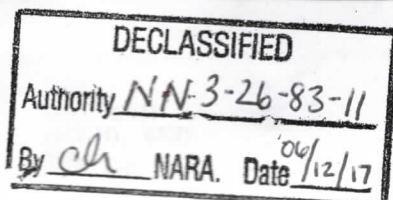
2. All duplicate Maritime Documents issued to members of the crew were checked with negative results.
