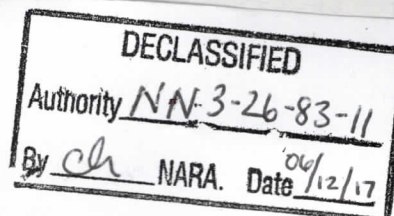

1. Check of crew list revealed CALIFANO, Leland John, CDB, 084886, Radio operator aboard Subject vessel listed on MMSL, 1 September, 1944 as being barred from sailing as Radio operator by Secretary of Navy on 25 August, 1943.

2. CALIFANO signed Coastwise articles aboard Subject vessel at Port Arthur, Texas on 19 January, 1945 from which date to the present, the ship called at Fort Lauderdale, Lake Charles, Boston, and Baton Rouge.

3. In accordance with instructions received from DCGIO, 6ND Dispatch No. 061337 (April), CALIFANO was signed off the articles by the Master and removed from the ship at 1200, 6 April, 1945.
