Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to British Registry and Flag of the

Tanker LA MESA


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on October 9, 1946, authorized the sale of the Tanker LA MESA, Official No. 246905, to Oriental Trade and Transport Company, Limited, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Dominion of Canada, with offices at 82 King Street, East, Toronto, Ontario, Canada, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 20th day of February 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835) of the Sale of the Tanker LA MESA, Official No. 246905, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to British registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
