Approving the Sale Alien of the SS LAKE CHELAN

WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission authorized the sale of the SS LAKE CHELAN, Official No. 216454 to British Iron & Steel Corporation (Salvage) Limited, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Great Britain, with offices at 7 Park Lane, London, W.l, upon the condition that said vessel shall not be operated nor used, except as provided in the Agreement dated September 8, 1948, Contract No. MCc-61414, between the United States of America, represented by the United States Maritime Commission, and British Iron & Steel Corporation (Salvage) Limited, but said vessel, including the hull, engines, machinery and major items of equipment, shall be completely scrapped, dismembered, dismantled, or destroyed as provided in said Agreement:

IT IS ORDERED, This 28th day of September 1948, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 41 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 839), of the sale of the SS LAKE CHELAN, Official No. 216454, to British Iron & Steel Corporation (Salvage) Limited, a British corporation, as above set forth and for the purpose above stated, be, and it is hereby granted.
