Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to  
Argentine Registry and Flag of the Steam Screw  
LAKE FREELAND

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Ford Motor Company, Dearborn, Michigan, for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw LAKE FREELAND, Official No. 217764, to "NAVEMAR Navegacion Maritima Sociedad Responsabilidad Limitada", an Argentine corporation, of Buenos Aires, Argentina, and the transfer of said vessel to Argentine registry and flag:


IT IS ORDERED, This 20th day of August 1946, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw LAKE FREELAND, Official No. 217764, to an alien, as above set forth, with transfer to Argentine registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens or encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
