2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 21 July 1941 from Georgetown, British Guiana with a cargo of 2078 tons of bauxite for this port. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with orders.
