## TEXT

YOUR 191500 PANAMA SS LEDA, FORMER YUGOSLAV DUBA, NOW OWNED BY COMPAÑIA LEDA DE VAPORES, PANAMA. NEW MASTER AND CREW GREEK NATIONALITY. HAVE NO KNOWLEDGE FORMER MOVEMENTS OF VESSEL. LOG BOOK WITH OTHER PAPERS OF DUBA RETAINED BY FORMER MASTER FOR DELIVERY TO YUGOSLAVIAN CONSUL NEW YORK. FORMER MASTER IN NEW YORK TODAY THURSDAY WILL RETURN PHILA FOR PERSONAL BELONGINGS. LOCAL NEWSPAPER ACCOUNTS QUOTED FORMER MASTER UPON ARRIVAL WILMINGTON ATTRIBUTING LONG DELAY ON TRIP FROM INDIA TO POORLY BURNING COAL TAKEN AT DURBAN SOUTH AFRICA. VESSEL DELAYED THAT PORT FOR TWO DAYS WEEKS AWAITING COAL. ITINERARY OF VESSEL GIVEN TO NEWSPAPERS AS FOLLOWS: DEPARTED QUELON INDIA 8 DEC. 1940. TOUCHED AT COHIN INDIA ONE DAY AND DEPARTED FOR DURBAN ARRIVING 31 DEC. DEPARTED DURBAN 15 JAN., 1941 WHEN FURTHER DELAY DUE TO POOR COAL OCCURED. ARRIVED WILMINGTON 8 MAR. FROM DURBAN. REGISTRY CHANGED 15 MAR. FULL NEWSPAPER ACCOUNTS FOLLOW BY MAIL.
