MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received information, from a reliable source, that Captain Bockoff, Master of the SS TK LIEBRE, violated a Port restriction in May, 1943. The Captain's vessel is reported to have stood out of a Port without permission when such Port was closed. It is reported the Captain was not cognizant of his violation and was concerned only with the safety of his vessel.

Action, if indicated, will be taken by the Coast Guard.
