Subj: Summary of information received in the Intelligence Division

The following from Aruba, N.W.I., dated 22 January, 1944, is forwarded for your information:

"The Master of the SS LIVINGSTON ROE reported a fire aboard his ship on 16 January, 1944, while at position 13-56N 71-23W. It was caused by a defective boiler. The flames were extinguished by the ship's crew with chemical apparatus. The fire did not spread beyond the boiler room."
