1. The following compilation from various reports is furnished you for information and any action believed necessary. Additional information is available, if desired:

2. Master of the American SS LONE STAR boarded at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on May 13, 1942, suggested that agents and Army men coming aboard ships in ports be required to ask no questions regarding ship movements. He proposed having the Coast Guard place a sign at the bottom of the gangways, requesting that persons boarding ships ask no questions regarding this subject.
