2. SUBJECT is apparently the same person, but he was not interviewed as he has just signed aboard this new ship.

3. John P. WISSING, Master of the BAMBERGER, was informed of SUBJECT'S suspected record as a Communist agitator. Captain WISSING advised he will closely observe SUBJECT'S activities while aboard this ship.
