Summary of Information:

Four (4) unlicensed crew members of the Panamanian motorship LUBRAFOL were removed at the request of the Master, after the ship's arrival at Bayonne, New Jersey, on 15 January, 1942, from Aruba, N.W.I.

These persons, all Belgians, were transferred to Immigration authorities at Ellis Island, New York: Louis Bierten, Renee Peeters, Marcel Van de Eynde and Peter de Pater. All are charged by the Master with being pro-Nazi trouble fomenters and he desired their removal for the safety of the ship.
