Summary of Information:

Subject vessel, which recently grounded off Cape Henry, Virginia, was floated on 5 December, 1941, and departed the Capes on 6 December, 1941, en route Baltimore. The LUBRAFOL was carrying a cargo of about 68,000 barrels of oil from Aruba, N. W. I.

Eugene Van Schoenberg, previously reported as being strong pro-Nazi, is the present master of the LUBRAFOL.
