Subject: Panamanian MS LUBRAPOL.

1. Information has been received from a reliable source stating that Eugene Van Schoenberg, master of subject vessel, and the crew are markedly pro-Nazi, even to the extent that the ship might endeavor to reach a German controlled port.
2. Subject vessel departed from Aruba on 9 September, 1941, and is expected to arrive at New York on 18 September, 1941.
3. Headquarters desires that the above stated report be investigated and the results of this investigation be submitted to Headquarters in sufficient time to be considered before the next departure of the vessel from New York.
