1. Subject vessel arrived from Cristobal, C.Z.
2. The following passengers were interviewed:
 - (a) PREVITI, Marte - US - Chemical Engr. - age 32 - employed by Allied Chemical Co. in Santiago, Chile since Oct 1940 and also served as Junior Econ. Analyst of the US Embassy in that city from May 1942 to Aug 1943. PREVITI stated that he intends to apply for placement in the Chemical Warfare Division, or the Air Corps of the US Army.
 - (b) FINNEGAN, Joseph Aloysius - US - fireman - age 38 - Seaman's PP #45253, issued Washington, D.C. 16 Sep 42. FINNEGAN joined SS ELIZABETH WHITE at San Francisco 7 Jan 43 and missed this vessel at Cristobal, C.Z., on 20 Sep 43 when ship sailed, according to FINNEGAN, prior to announced time. He was held in quarantine until 27 Sep 43 and repatriated on subject vessel as a workaway.
 - (c) JOHNSON, Harry Edwin - US - Carpenter - age 46 - CG card #201032, issued San Francisco 31 Dec 42. Johnson joined SS ELIZABETH WHITE at San Francisco 7 Jan 43 and missed the sailing of this vessel at Cristobal, C.Z., on 20 Sep 43 when ship sailed, according to Johnson, prior to announced time. He was held in quarantine until 27 Sep 43 and repatriated as a workaway on subject vessel. He stated his seaman's papers were on the SS ELIZABETH WHITE.
 - (d) LUPIEN, Harold Grant - US - Chief Cook - age 49 - Z #390970, issued NY 14 Jun 43. Lupien joined SS BARSTOW at NY 4 Jul 43 and was hospitalized for heart trouble at Gorgas Hospital, Balboa 23 Jul 43 to 31 Jul 43. He was then placed in the seamen's quarantine until 26 Sep 43 when he was repatriated on subject vessel as a workaway.

(e) KINKHEAD, Scott Hillen - US - mesaman - age 18 - E #406465 issued NY 19 Aug 43. KINKHEAD joined the SS CAPE SPENCER at NY 21 Aug 43, but was hospitalised at Margarita Hospital, Cristobal, C.Z., 1 Sep 43 to 17 Sep 43 with pneumonia. Held in seasons quarantine until 26 Sep when he was repatriated as a workaway on subject vessel.
