Approving the Sale Alien of the

St. Sc. M. H. DE YOUNG


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission, on January 29, 1948, authorized the sale of its steam screw M. H. DE YOUNG (ex-ANTELOPE), Official No. 243893, to the Asia Development Corporation, a company established and existing under the laws of the Republic of China, with offices at Shanghai, China, pursuant to Contract No. MCC-61131, dated February 2, 1948, which provides that the hull or hulk of said vessel shall be completely scrapped, dismembered, dismantled, or destroyed:

IT IS ORDERED, This 11th day of March 1948, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 41 of the Shipping Act, 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 839), of the sale of the steam screw M. H. DE YOUNG (ex-ANTELOPE), Official No. 243893, to an alien, as above set forth, be, and it is hereby granted.
