MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,  
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received reliable information concerning the conduct of officers of the SS M. M. GUBIN in May, 1943.

1. Abraham S. Tomnessen, Captain, is reported for frequent drinking aboard ship at sea, and violation of convoy orders.
2. Frederick Williams, First Mate, is reported for excessive drinking aboard ship at sea, bringing liquor on board and violation of convoy orders and blackout restrictions.
3. David Schneider, 2nd Mate, and Emanuel Hogh, Chief Engineer are reported to have been drinking aboard ship at sea.

Necessary action will be taken by the Coast Guard in these cases.
