Subject: Honduran Steamer "Makawao".

1. The subject vessel is owned by the Matson Navigation Co. of San Francisco, California and is registered at Puerto Cortes, Honduras. This vessel is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 7 June 1940 for a period of 18 months.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 2 October 1941 from Georgetown, British Guiana with a cargo of 2244 tons of bauxite for Port Alfred, Canada. She entered this port to take on an additional 2350 tons also for Port Alfred, Canada. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company the radio for the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with orders.
