1. The subject vessel is owned by the Matson Navigation Co. of San Francisco, California and is registered at Puerto Cortes, Honduras. This vessel is under charter to Saguenay Terminals Limited from 7 June 1940 for a period of 18 months.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 9 July 1941 from Savannah, Georgia. She entered this port to take on a cargo of 4500 tons of bauxite for Port Alfred, Canada. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with orders.
