1. The subject vessel is owned by the Matson Navigation Company Of San Francisco, California and is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 11 July 1940 for a period of eighteen to nineteen months.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 12 February 1941 with a cargo of bauxite from Georgetown, British Guiana to be discharged at this port. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with orders.
