1. The subject vessel is owned by the Matson Navigation Company of San Francisco, California and is registered at Puerto Cortes Honduras. This vessel is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 11 July, 1940 for a period of eighteen months.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 14 November, 1940 with a part cargo of bauxite from Georgetown, British Guiana. After loading additional bauxite at this port the vessel proceeded to Port Alfred, Canada. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed in compliance with instructions.
