1. The subject vessel is owned by the Matson Navigation Company of San Francisco, California and is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 11 July, 1940 for a period of eighteen months.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 12 October, 1940 with a part cargo of bauxite from Georgetown, British Guiana and departed the same date for Port Alfred, Canada, having completed the loading of a full cargo at this port. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival in compliance with instructions.
