1. The subject vessel is owned by the Matson Navagation Company of San Francisco, California and is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 11 July, 1940 for a period of eighteen months.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 11 September, 1940 with a cargo of bauxite from Georgetown, British Guiana to be discharged at this place. The Saguenay Terminals being a British Company the radio of the vessel was sealed as soon as weather conditions permitted boarding of the vessel.
