1. The subject vessel is owned by the Matson Navigation Company of San Francisco, California and is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 11 July, 1940 for a period of eighteen months.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 20 July, 1940 with a cargo of coal to be discharged at this place from Norfolk, Va. The vessel is at present anchored in harbor awaiting berth at dock. The Saguenay Terminals being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed in compliance with orders.
