Subject: Honduran Steamer "Mana".

1. The subject vessel is owned by the Matson Navigation Company of San Francisco, California and is registered at Puerto Cortes, Honduras. This vessel is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 7 June 1940 to 7 December 1941.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 19 April 1941 from Trinidad with a cargo of 2642 tons of bauxite for Port Alfred, Canada. She entered this port to take on an additional 1700 tons of bauxite also for Port Alfred, Canada. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with orders.
