The subject vessel is owned by the Matson Navigation Company of San Francisco, California and is registered at Puerto Cortes, Honduras. This vessel is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 7 June 1940 to 7 December 1941.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 17 March 1941 from Rio de Janeiro with a cargo of 4700 tons of Manganese Ore. This vessel entered this port to take on 500 tons of oil for fuel. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with orders.
