1. The subject vessel is owned by the Matson Navigation Company of San Francisco, California and is registered at Puerto Cortes, Honduras. This vessel is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 7 June 1940 to 7 December 1940.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 1 February 1941, from Georgetown, British Guiana, with a cargo of 2484 tons of bauxite to discharge at this port. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with orders.
