Subject: Honduran steamer " MANA "

1. The subject vessel is owned by the Matson Navigation Company of San Francisco, California and is registered at Puerto Cortes, Honduras. This vessel is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 19 June 1940 for a period of 18 to 19 months.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 9 January 1941, from Georgetown, British Guiana, with a cargo of 2200 tons of bauxite to discharge at this port. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with orders.
