1. The subject vessel is owned by Matson Navigation Company of San Francisco, California and registered at Puerto Cortes, Honduras. This vessel is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals, Limited from 19 July, 1940 for a period of 18 to 19 months.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 1 November, 1940 with a cargo of 2353 tons of bauxite from Georgetown British Guiana to be discharged at this place. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival in compliance with orders.
