2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 30 September, 1940 with a cargo of bauxite from Georgetown, British Guiana to be discharged at this port. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with instructions.
