1. The files of another government agency were checked and revealed the following information on one Raymond Kingman WORBASS:

WORBASS was strongly suspected of committing sabotage on Sawyer Master Blower at the Charleston Navy Yard. General investigation revealed that WORBASS is a surly, overbearing individual with an unsavory reputation, who drinks considerably on and off the job. WORBASS has been suspended from the Charleston Navy Yard for drunkenness. Informants at the yard advised that his workmanship is poor and that the CNY would be better off without his services.

2. Raymond K. WORBASS, Ass't Electrician aboard the USAHS MARIGOLD is identical with SUBJECT of above information.

3. The presence of WORBASS aboard the USAHS MARIGOLD was brought to the attention of Master, Chief Mate and Chief Engineer aboard the MARIGOLD. The Chief Engineer advised that WORBASS is a very good electrician but that he hasn't associated with WORBASS long enough to make a characterization. The Master advised that they would keep WORBASS under strict surveillance while aboard the MARIGOLD and report any misconduct to Coast Guard Intelligence at the first port of call.
