5. Requirements of law or regulations on which waiver is requested
To permit the above named vessel to carry not exceeding 130 persons consisting of 150 Merchant crew and 300 Passengers. This vessel will carry lifeboats, liferafts and lifelines of sufficient combined capacity to accommodate all persons on board.

6. Period of time for which waiver is requested Until expiration of the current Certificate of Inspection

7. Extent to which requested waiver will affect the safety of the vessel and the persons on board Not Applicable

8. Reasons why waiver is necessary It is necessary in the War Effort to carry Military Passengers and in the National Interest to carry Civilian Passengers to the number indicated above and that the vessel depart on scheduled times specified in orders issued by the Military Authorities. It is not practicable to reconstruct and/or equip this vessel so that she can obtain a certificate authorizing the carrying of passengers in the number indicated above.

I hereby certify that in my opinion waiver of compliance with the requirements of law specified above is necessary in the conduct of war.
