Subj: SS MARK HANNA, Ammunition Ship moored
at Pier 4OB, Honolulu, T.H.; report on
fire aboard

There was received at HQ a letter from the
DCCO, LAND (int) dated 5 July, 1945, submitting
a report on the above case for HQ information.
As appears from said report at 1600, 2 July,
1945, flames were breaking out of a finger-hy-
lift in #2 hold of the MARK HANNA; that an
inspection of the finger-hy-lift, revealed that
the main electrical circuit was not protected
at any point by fuses.

Both letter and report are being forwarded
to Lt. Comdr. McFaul, of Legal, for action.
Case may be closed in this office.
