Approving the Charter to an Alien of  
the tanker MEMORY


WHEREAS, An application has been filed by North American Shipping and Trading Company, Inc., New York, N.Y., for the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the charter of the tanker MEMORY, Official No. 247100, to Compania Internacional de Vapores, Ltda., a Panamanian corporation, for a period of ten years from November 6, 1947, covering consecutive voyages with petroleum and its products for world-wide trading:

IT IS ORDERED, This 7th day of November 1947, that the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the charter of the tanker MEMORY, Official No. 247100, to an alien for a period of ten years from November 6, 1947, for operation as above set forth, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that (1) said vessel shall remain under United States registry and flag during the period of said charter, and (2) said vessel shall not be sub-chartered to an alien without the prior approval of the Maritime Commission, except as may be permitted by General Order No. 59.
