Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to Turkish Registry and Flag of the SS MEXICO

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by the New York and Cuba Mail Steamship Company, New York, N. Y., for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw MEXICO, Official No. 231976 to "Devlet Denizyollari ve Limanlari Isletne Genel Mudurlugu" (Turkish State Seaways & Harbors, a Turkish Government agency), Istanbul, Turkey, with transfer to Turkish registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 7th day of November, 1946, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the S/S MEXICO, Official No. 231976, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Turkish registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens nor encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
