- 1. The MICHIGAN was torpedeed and sunk in the Mediterranean Sea on 20 April, 1943, and although the survivors of the subject vessel were repatriated to New York, N. Y., and there paid off, no survivors were interviewed, as required by the above references.
- 2. Capt. Jacobson, the senior survivor of the MICHIGAN, is now the master of the JOHN McLOUGHLIN, which vessel is scheduled to arrive in the port of New York on 11 September, 1943. Upon the arrival of this vessel at New York, Capt. Jacobson is to be interviewed in conformance with the instructions contained in references (a), (b) and (c).
