WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Erle P. Halliburton, Inc., Los Angeles, California, for the approval required by Sections 9 and 41 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 839), of the transfer of the tanker MISSION SANTA MARIA, Official No. 246222, to Panamanian registry and flag, incident to the sale of said vessel to Greenwich Shipping Corporation, a citizen of the United States:


IT IS ORDERED, This 17th day of December 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 41 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 839), of the transfer of the tanker MISSION SANTA MARIA, Official No. 246222, to Panamanian registry and flag, as above set forth, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens or encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to Panamanian registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, is effected within six months of the date of such approval.
