TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-6101

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to Netherlands Registry and Flag of the

Oil Screw MORMACDOVE


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on March 1, 1948, authorized the sale of its oil screw MORMACDOVE (ex-ALCHIBA, former Official No. 238987), to the Kingdom of the Netherlands, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 17th day of March 1948, that the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act, 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the sale of the oil screw MORMACDOVE (ex-ALCHIBA, former Official No. 238987), to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Netherlands registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
